We will start off the first day by running large teams of 10-14 dogs on a breathtakingly beautiful scenic 10 to 20 mile outing. You will be accompanied by a skilled Musher guide, to help you,
- Learn and develop the skills you will need to be able to run your own team over the next few days. The following days we will break these squadrons down into 4-6 dog teams (depending upon snow conditions), and if you have learned your skills well, you will be driving your own dog team through the winter mountainside trail system.
- These dogs are the real thing, winning genetics, highly trained and socialized, and the experience they offer you is a very authentic one.
- Each day here will include a half day of educational and fun dogsledding, with the other half day available for snowshoeing, Nordic skiing, downhill skiing, or just kicking back and relaxing at the lodge.
